Rules of play -

- A member of the Cob staff will be present in the Party Paddock for the duration of the party, but it is not a 'hosted' party, the children are the responsibility of the adults present at the party.
- To secure your booking, a 50% deposit is required and full payment a week before the party.
- All food and drink must be provided by the Cob House, with the exception of a birthday cake.
- We understand that toys can be get damaged in the process of play, but if we feel the equipment provided in the Party Paddock is not being used in the correct manner or in a respectful way then we hold the right to close the Party Paddock early.
- Your booking is not confirmed until we have received a 50% deposit and you have had confirmation from the Cob House.
- If you are booking additional entertainment, such as Doorstep Princesses, Bouncy Castle ect, these are the hirer responsibility to co-ordinate dropping off and collection.
- Whilst all precautions will be taken to highlight any hazards within the Party Paddock, children will need to be supervised by their own adults/the hirer and we do not accept responsibility for any injuries caused by playing with the equipment incorrectly.
